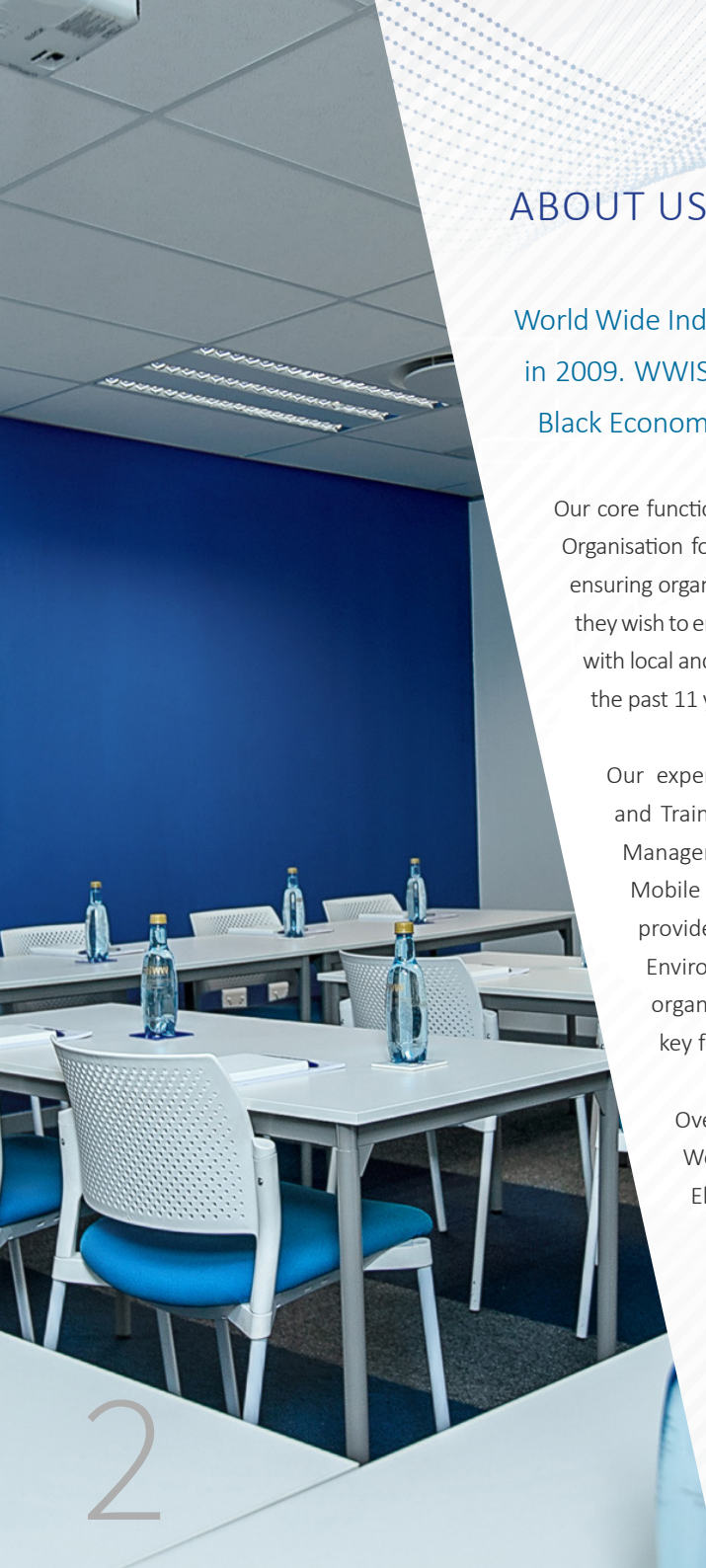

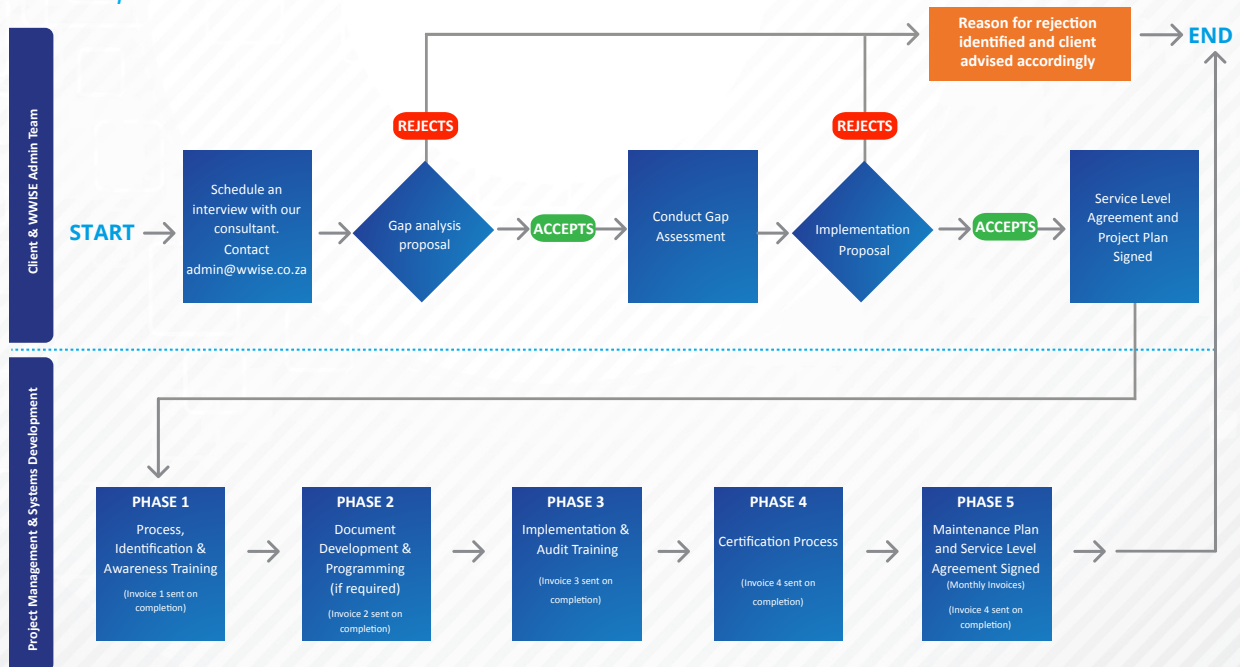

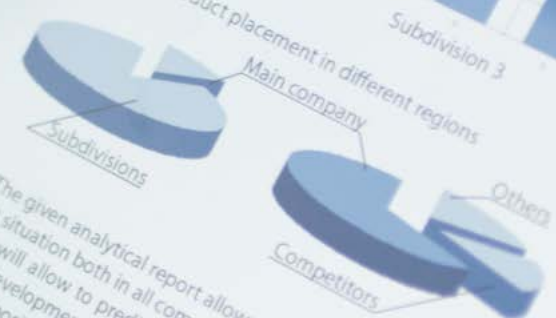
The ISO Implementation Process
