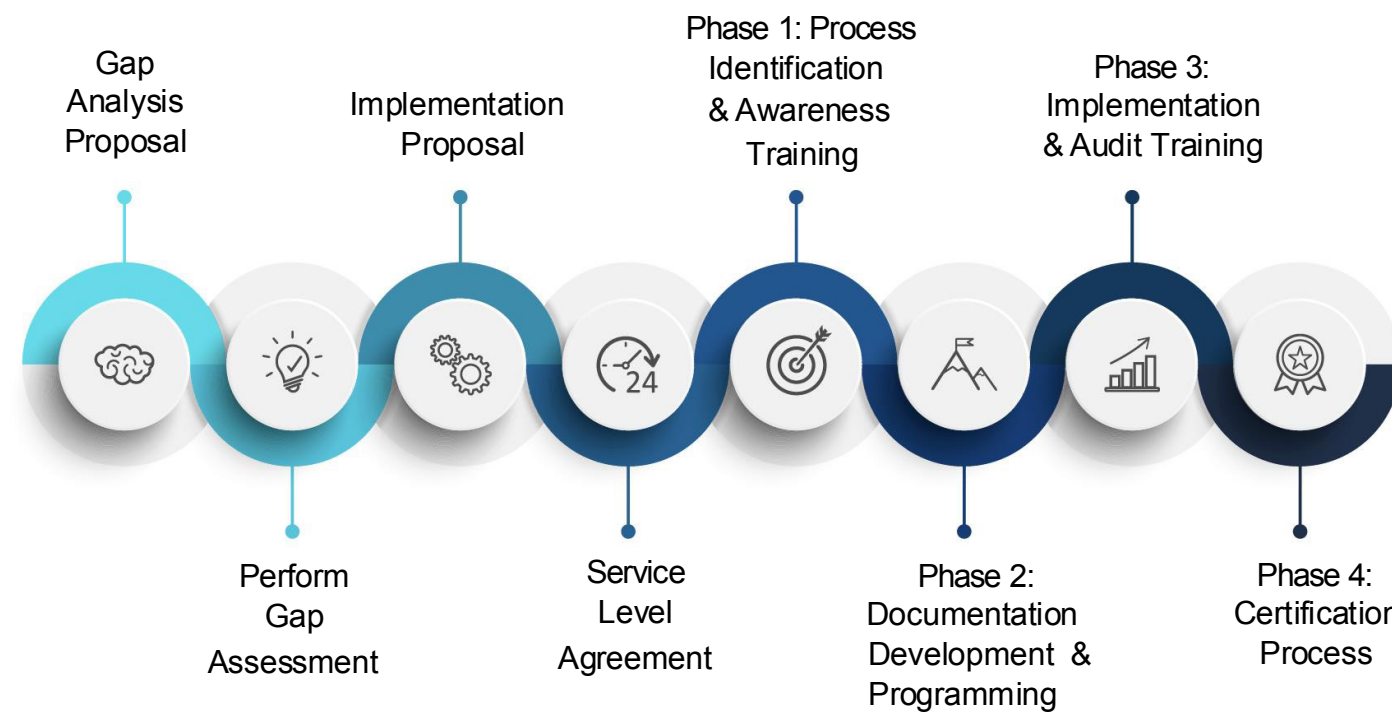

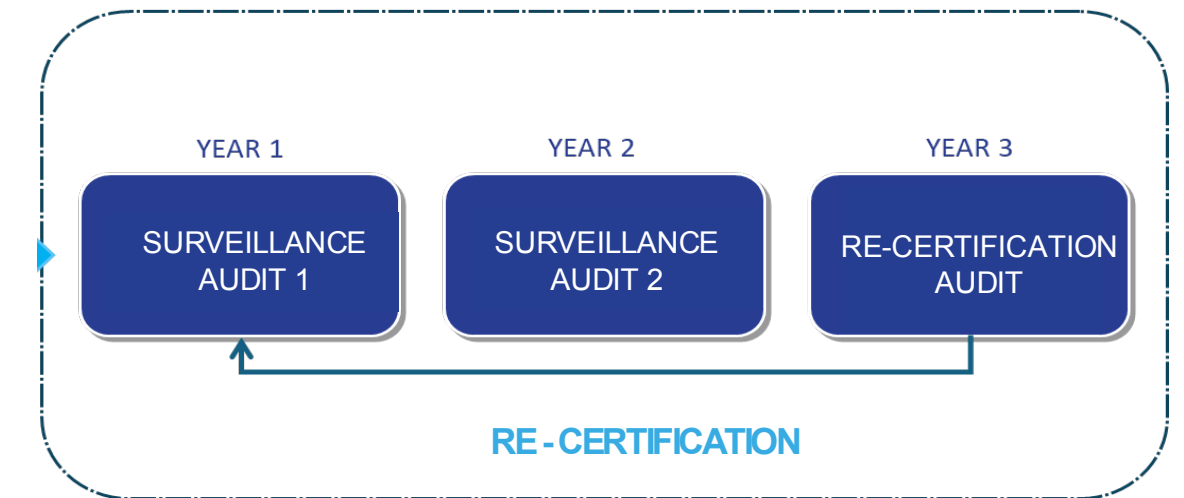

12 Steps of Maintenance

- Step 1:** Reviewing, editing, and maintaining mandatory documentations aligned to the specific ISO standard.
- Step 2:** Reviewing, editing, and maintaining the current process documentation.
- Step 3:** Reviewing, editing, and maintaining the Risk Assessment to the specific ISO standard.
- Step 4:** Awareness training for employees.
- Step 5:** Internal audit on the specific ISO standard as per the Internal Audit Schedule (with on-the-job training where required).
- Step 6:** Assisting with issuing and closing of non-conformances raised during internal audits and correcting the corrective actions, updating the risks assessment accordingly.
- Step 7:** Assisting with strategic objectives analysis and statistical reviews.
- Step 8:** Operationalising ISO standard with ISO Champions and Governance meetings, managing weekly / monthly issue registers.
- Step 9:** Non-conformances, corrective and preventive action reports, management review, maintain meeting actions, and legal compliance aligned to specific ISO standard.
- Step 10:** Reviewing departmental process inputs and verifying their outputs related to specific ISO standard's clauses, objectives, risks, and key performance indicators.
- Step 11:** Assisting during external audits and closing off findings from external audits.
- Step 12:** Encouraging organisations to streamline processes using Microsoft applications for efficient document and record-keeping.
